Explanatory Notes

The Hall School Museum contains over 1200 individual items including a school library of approximately 700 books, dating from late nineteenth century through early twentieth century, together with an historic collection of 62 sheet music items. The Museum is particularly strong in its collection of manuscript material detailing the history and progress of the school from its establishment in 1911 to its closure in 2006. Included in the collection is not only a unique variety of early twentieth century classroom furniture and teaching aids, but also an exceptionally historic collection of early audio visual equipment, signifying the beginnings of the use of mechanical and early audio visual machines in class room teaching and early and mid- twentieth century learning environments and styles. Accompanying this Inventory is a CD disk of approximately 30 digitized colour photographs of selected items in the Museum, together with general perspective images of the furniture arrangement in the classroom and annex.. To facilitate the location, in the museum, of items listed in this inventory, we have labeled the cupboards and display cases. The key to the location code follows.:

Notes to Accompany Inventory of Storeroom

In February 2008 the Inventory of Items in the Classroom and Annex of the Hall School Museum was compiled by members of the Australian National Museum of Education for the Properties Group of the ACT Government. At that time, because the key of the Hall School Museum Storeroom could not be located by the Properties Office, it was not possible then to include the Storeroom contents in the initial inventory. Subsequently, in early 2009 access to the Storeroom was obtained and the ANME undertook, as a separate project, to produce an Inventory of the Storeroom, which was found to contain over 700 individual items, now listed herein.

To our surprise our volunteers were delighted to find a number of original documents relating to Hall School from 1920s onwards. We undertook, at our expense, the task of filing these documents and records into archival sleeves and folders. Our volunteers listed and collated these records and then relocated, for safe keeping and preservation, these documents into the document boxes stored in lockable steel presses in the Hall School Museum Annex. Also among the disorganized clutter in the Storeroom was the Hall School's Library of over 300 books and pamphlets which have now been individually listed in this Storeroom Inventory. It is important that this school library collection be kept together, as an historical artifact. Its historical value, and integrity as a school library collection in its original educational context, as such would be depreciated considerably if books were removed from it, or the library moved away from the Hall School Museum.

To ensure the safekeeping of this historical School Library collection, it is necessary that the Storeroom be rendered waterproof, as we were distressed to find that water had entered the storeroom during storms and a number of books and items were damaged and damp stained as a consequence.
